



CHEMICAL FIRST AID

Always have product container or label when calling poison control center or going for treatment.

IF IN EYES

- **Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.**
- **Remove contact lenses, if being worn, before rinsing eye. Do not use eye drops or chemicals or drugs in the wash water.**
- **Call poison control center for additional treatment advice immediately after initiating rinse treatment.**

IF SWALLOWED

- **Immediately call poison control center. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by poison control center.**
- **Do not give anything by mouth unless recommended by poison control center.**

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING

- **Take off contaminated clothing.**
- **Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Wash skin and hair with soap and water. Put on clean clothing.**
- **Call poison control center for treatment advice.**
- **Discard contaminated clothing or thoroughly wash clothing separately in hot, soapy water. NEVER re-wear contaminated clothing until it has been laundered.**

IF INHALED

- **Move person to fresh air if you know the environment/location will not present a hazard to you. Otherwise, call 911 for self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) before attempting to remove the victim.**
- **Keep person warm. , If person collapses in a closed space facility, do not enter unless you have SCBA. Call 911.**
- **If person is not breathing but has a pulse, call 911, then give artificial respiration by mouth-to-mouth (if you know it.) Use a rescuer pocket mask if possible. If there is no pulse, begin CPR (chest compressions).**
- **Call poison control center for treatment advice.**
