



Qualitative Fit Test Hygiene- COVID-19

Fit Tester will:

- Not conduct fit tests if they themselves have symptoms of COVID-19.
- Wear a minimum of a surgical grade disposable mask and gloves if a mask mandate is in place or the fit tester prefers. (Gloves also recommended to prevent getting sensitivity/fit test solution on hands).
- Use the same hood for a subject that was used during the sensitivity test for that subject.
- Use one set of nebulizers for each subject being fit tested.
- Disinfect the inside of hoods, the outer surfaces of nebulizer nozzles, and surfaces between each fit test with EPA cleaner approved for use against COVID-19.

- At the end of the fit test session, discard unused solution and clean any remaining solution from the nebulizer, per the fit test kit User Instructions.
- Clean and disinfect respirators between fit tests following the OSHA standard if respirators from fit test kit are being used. [New RespiratorCleaningSlide 2020 01 07 11x17 poster.pdf \(ncagromedicine.org\)](#) Preferably, individuals being fit tested should bring their own respirator if they already have one.
- Practice regular hand hygiene using an alcohol-based sanitizer between fit tests, washing hands thoroughly as often as possible.
- Practice appropriate social distancing when not engaged in actual fit test activities.
- Ensure that only one participant and one staff person are in the assigned fit test area at a time.

Participants will:

- Complete temperature check and symptoms questionnaire upon arrival. If they answer yes to any of the questions of their temperature is greater than 100, fit test will need to be rescheduled.
- Be asked to remain at an appropriate social distancing location until they are contacted for fit testing.
- Be required, at a minimum if a mask mandate is in place, to wear a cloth or disposable face covering, except during the actual fit testing process.
- Bring their own respirator for fitting unless they are being fitted for the first time or changing respirators.
